Legal Report

Mr. Fano also reported he wasn't successful on convincing legal counsel for the RV Company to allow the purchase of the RV while subject to a government recall.

Northglenn Ambulance Report:

Melissa gave a brief report on September call volumes of 815 calls. About 160 more than last year at this time. She reported on mutual aid in District was 6 and out of District was 8. Nine instances greater than 4 ADCOM calls at a time. Average length





per incidence was 4 minutes. Average response time for emergency was 4:26 and nonemergent was 7:00.
